The program aims to provide the first extramural grant to establish labs and initiate research in the frontier areas of biotechnology.

Eligibility Criteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none">> The Principal investigator should be below 40 years holding independent position (and within 10 years of receiving a PhD).> Each application should have Co-PI (preferably below 50 years) with prior experience of grant management> Applicants must be from non-profit organisations and should have demonstrated a promising track-record of early achievements appropriate to his/her research field and career stage, including significant publications (as main author) in international peer-reviewed scientific journals.
Fiscal Incentive	> RGYI provides startup grants to young investigators across the country working in different settings such as central government funded institutions, State Government funded University departments, scientists at DSIR approved private institutions etc.
